

## **London Procurement Strategy Board (LPSB)**

### **TERMS OF REFERENCE**

#### **Purpose and Objectives**

Develop and sponsor a procurement strategy and category management strategy for London local government with the objective of delivering significant cashable efficiency savings.

Develop and manage a work plan for delivery of the agreed procurement strategy.

Work with key stakeholders to build wider support and ownership of this strategy and ensure effective implementation of such.

Act as a champion for effective procurement within London local government.

Take collective responsibility for driving forward further collaboration opportunities between boroughs in relation to procurement.

Act as the governance board (when required) for London wide procurement projects.

Review existing and proposals for new framework structures across London in order to support the development of a consistent and coherent approach with the objective of increasing the take up of framework contracts within London and promoting committed spend in contract notices.

Provide a forum for sharing expertise, learning and good practice between London local authorities

#### **Membership**

The Strategy Board will be chaired by the Procurement lead for the Society of London Treasurers and membership will consist of:

- A Society of London Treasurers representative
- The Chair of the London Procurement Network (Heads of Procurement Group)
- A Head of Procurement representative from each of the sub-regional shared services groupings:
  - East London Solutions (ELS)
  - North London Strategic Alliance (NLSA)
  - South West London Procurement Partnership (SWLPP)
  - South East London Procurement Partnership (SELPP)West London Alliance (WLA)
- Director of Fair Funding, Performance and Procurement – London Councils
